The restaurant at the Renaissance Midtown recently revamped, introducing the upscale, New American spot **Community Smith**. The rooftop space also features a selection of bar bites, cocktails and a solid selection of greenery.

**The View:** You're mostly overlooking West Peachtree traffic, but look up and across the street to glimpse the old Biltmore Hotel signs.

**What to Order:** Community Smith relies on seasonal ingredients and may change its drinks — grab an old fashioned made with blood-orange juice if it's on the menu; it's a successfully subtle change to a classic cocktail.
